Important Information on Your Trial Veneers

Congratulations! You have just gone through the preparation stage of your new smile.

As with any cosmetic surgery, your results are nowhere near complete.

Here is what we have done to this point:

- We have begun to “conceive” your smile.
- We have prepared your teeth for the final veneers/crowns.
- We have placed trial veneers to protect your teeth till the final veneers are completed.

Here is what is left to do:

- **We need to see you for a short visit to take an impression of your trial veneers.**
- We must see you without any anesthetic to assess the length, color shape, and bite.
- We must record your likes and dislikes.
- We must translate that information to create your final smile.

Here is what you need to do until your next visit:

- Be careful with these trial veneers. They are fragile and cemented loosely so they can be removed without trauma to your teeth.
- **You must keep them immaculately clean. Use syringes with fuzzy tip applicators with hydrogen peroxide around the trial veneers 3x/day for the next two weeks. Then, use chlorhexidine 3x/day for final week before insertion appointment.**
Super floss at least twice a day.
- Unhealthy or bleeding gums will compromise your final result.
- Make notes on what your want to changes so your “evaluation visit” is quick and we can go to the finished smile.

The trial veneers may loosen or dislodge. This may be due to your bite, a tooth grinding habit, or a “thin” area. Don’t panic. Lay low and we will see you as soon as humanely possible.
